STRIKE ACTION:

You will be aware that teachers have voted to go on strike on Wednesday May 29. This has come about because the Government and Ministry have not listened to us. We want:

- better resourcing for teaching and for students as we believe that appropriate resourcing is not available to meet the needs of our students;
- more time to plan and prepare and lead as the current allocation is inadequate;
- a pay jolt so that we can keep the teachers we have. A significant number of teachers are leaving after about five years as they can earn more money in other areas.
 We need these things now.

Please help support us and let the government know that they should be doing something to get this sorted as soon as possible.

There will be no school on Wednesday 29 May, so please make arrangements to have your child looked after on that day.
