- We are needing staff to be paid more as another reason teachers leave is to go to a higher paying job with less stress.
- Teachers are needing more time for planning, preparation and assessment – currently there is not enough.

We all want the best for the children and we need the Government and Ministry to know that our children need these things and they need them now.

Our staff are currently reviewing both our Literacy and Numeracy curriculums to ensure that they are up to date and meet the needs of our students. We want the children more involved in their learning.

I am proud of the current programmes operating and the work that our teachers put in.

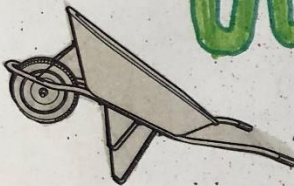
