Last week rooms 1, 2, 3, 19 and the year 5's from room 4 had a whole week of Outdoor Education.

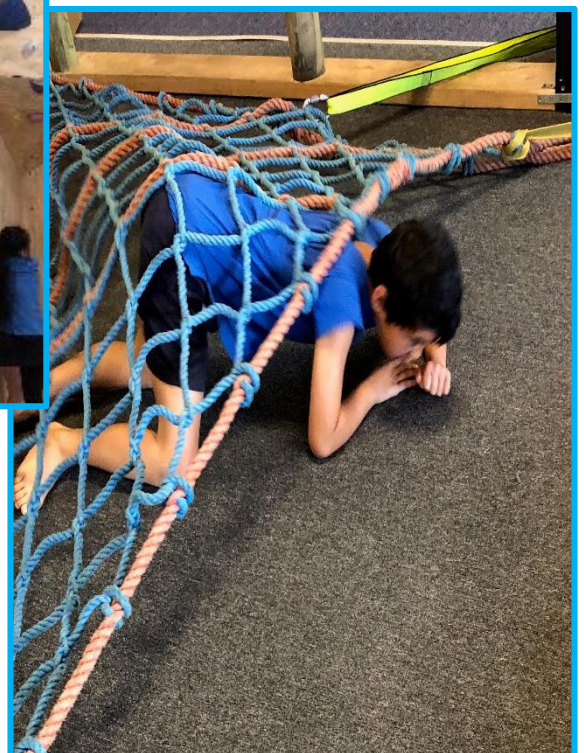
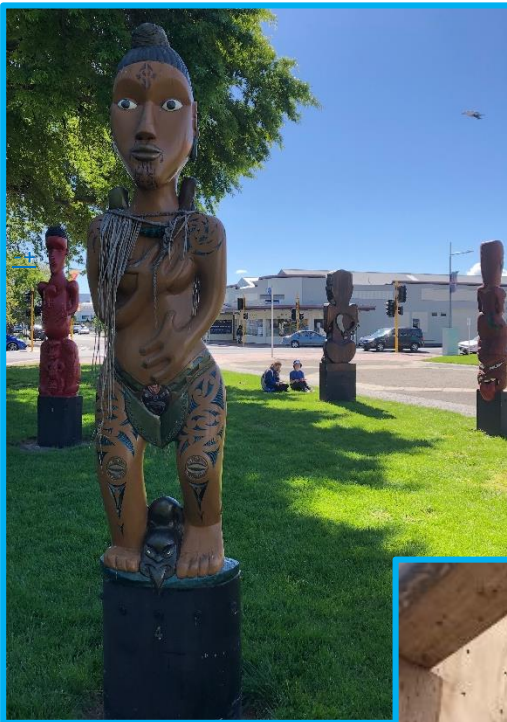
On Tuesday we had rotations with different teachers that included mapping, cooking, co-operative games and a scavenger hunt.
