Congratulations to Chris Holdaway our Administration Manager. Chris has been working at Raureka for 35 years today. We thank Chris for all her hard work over the years.






## Let's have a peek into Room 19 ... What have you got to share with us this week?








Foto iwi are running their school holiday creative workshops 13-17 July.


