Fees

If you attest your 20 ECE hours to the kindergarten your fees will be as shown in the table below. Depending on your circumstances, you may be able to access WINZ subsidies to cover fees. The cost of any hours above the designated ECE hours per day would be **\$5.00 per hour**.
